Play Therapy

Assists with age appropriate play and learning by doing.

Fine Motor Skills

Grasping, Zipping, Buttoning, Fastening, and Turning objects

Hand-Eye Coordination

Handwriting, balance, carrying items , and sports and exercise.

Activities of Daily Living

Bathing, Dressing, Self-Feeding, Grooming, Brushing Teeth.

Cognitive/Behavioral Disorders

Positive Behaviors, Social Skills, & Managing Anger

Ordering and Training for Orthotics and Assistive Devices

Splints, Braces, Dressing Devices, Bathing & Communication Devices
